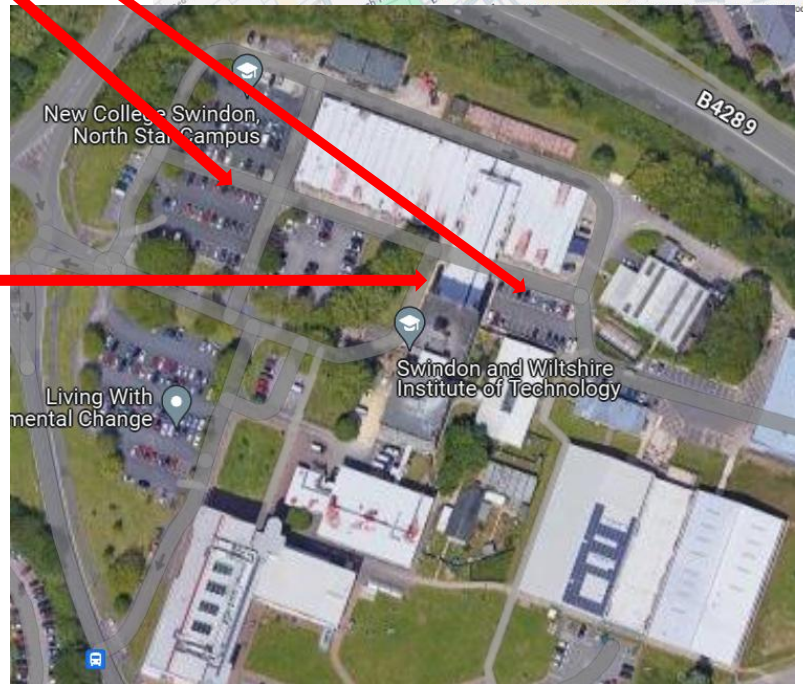
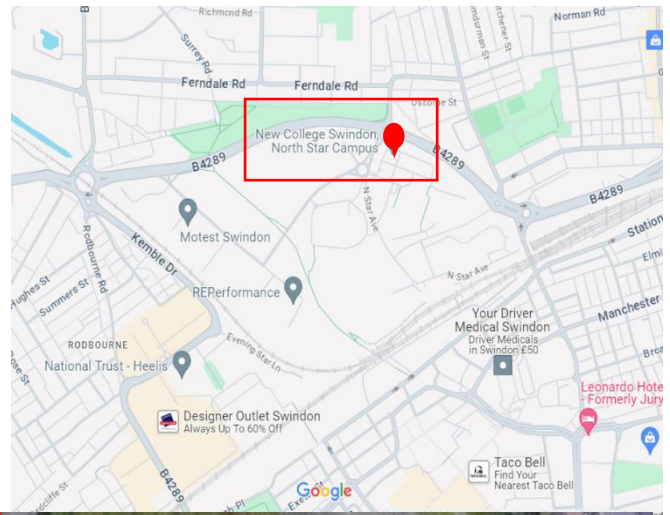

Getting there. Please use public transport where possible.

Buses: Route 15/16 run every 30 mins directly to the North Star campus.

Route 11/12 run every 15 mins, with a short walk to the campus.

Car parking onsite is free for course attendees. (Cars left at own risk). The car park is lit and has CCTV cameras.

On arrival: Please assemble in the foyer, just inside the Institute of Technology (IOT) reception entrance. This can be found to the left of the Pegasus building, as you enter from the main road. The trainer will collect you to take you to the training room. **For safeguarding purposes, please do not make your own way to the training classrooms.**

All Trust staff attending must bring a valid GWH ID.

Please ensure you arrive on time. As the trainer needs to collect you from the assembly point, late arrival is likely to cause significant disruption to training which has already commenced. If you arrive up to 15 minutes late, please wait in reception for a second collection. After 15 minutes, please call the Academy on 01793 604416.

Late arrival will cause significant disruption to training.

Safeguarding: A yellow lanyard will be issued to you at the start of your training. Please ensure you wear this at all times whilst onsite.

Staff wearing both a yellow lanyard and valid GWH ID will be able to move unescorted between the reception area and the third floor.

Staff from other trusts will need to be accompanied when moving around the building outside of accessing the third-floor toilets.

Please remain within the training area on the third floor where possible and do not enter any other classrooms/teaching areas.

Accessibility: The site is wheelchair accessible, with lift access to the third-floor training room.

Refreshments: There is a kitchenette with a cold/boiling drinking water tap and a fridge. We advise bringing a packed lunch. There is a microwave available. There is no access to the college canteen facilities but there is a petrol station with a shop a short walk away from the college. You will require both an NHS ID and yellow IOT lanyard to return onsite.

Smoking: Please be aware that no smoking/vaping is permitted onsite.

Health and Safety: Please alert your trainer to any health and safety issues, including any mobility issues that may impact evacuation in the event of a fire.
